### **Section 1**

Discuss what you applied in the past seven days from the last Overflow Show.

Read Titus 3:1-8. Choose parts of this passage that might apply to our attitudes and actions as we relate to homosexual friends in general and as we help point them to Christ.

### **Section 3**

What did you think? What stood out to you as you listened?

Quite a bit of this podcast describes various characteristics of a friendship. What characteristic seemed the most important to you?

What is important about inviting your gay friend to social events? Name some examples of events.

The book says not to put a time frame on your friend's progress. What is it referring to and how could you see that playing out negatively?

Discuss and/or critique this statement: The opposite of homosexuality is heterosexuality.

What does the book say about the possibility of a reformed homosexual having a satisfying sex life?

## **Section 4**

Discuss some ways we could apply a few of these principles in the next 7 days?

*One suggestion (if needed): Spend 5 minutes now in the group silently journaling. Each group member could write down the name of a homosexual acquaintance or friend, even if it is just someone who serves you at a store or business. Plan a gesture that you could do this week as you cross paths with them to show interest in their life and friendship.*

*Meet back next week to report on the encounter.*
